Meeting summary

The meeting began at 5:30 PM. Steve Godfrey explained that the meeting would talk about the Alternatives Meeting.

Alternatives Meeting

The meeting began at 5:30 PM. Steve Godfrey explained that the meeting would focus on the information, materials and exhibits to be presented at the upcoming Alternatives Meeting. The Alternatives Meeting is set for November 13, 2008. This meeting will take place at Tallahassee Community College (TCC) Economic Workforce Development (EWD) Building, Room 105 from 5:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Alternatives Meeting Presentation and Exhibits

A short presentation will be given at the beginning of the meeting. Following the presentation, the public will break up into four work groups, one for each segment. Steve discussed the information and exhibits that would be presented to each of the four work groups:

- Analyses Summary Tables - Quantitative descriptions of the environmental and social impacts for each segment.
- Environmental Involvement Map – Graphic (visual) representation of the segment alignment environmental impacts to wetlands, floodplains, surface waters, vegetation and wildlife, etc.
- Social Involvement Map – Graphic (visual) representation of the segment alignment impacts to residences, businesses, historic and archeological resources, and noise impacts
- Segment Evaluation Tables – Summarizes information in the analyses summary tables and describes the relative impacts (low, medium, high) and enhancements between the alternatives within each segment per the 13 IA approved categories.

The group provided input on the color scheme depicting the relative impacts within the evaluation tables. Steve stated that the evaluation tables would be provided in a handout to the public.

Steve briefly went through the PowerPoint presentation to be given at the Alternatives Meeting. In the presentation, Steve will provide a brief history of project, a description of the segment alternatives, a summary of the ETDM comments, and an overview of the information contained in the evaluation tables. Steve will also explain how the workgroup activity will be facilitated. At the end of the workgroups, each group will be given an opportunity to present their recommendation for the best solution within that segment. Additional time will also be allotted for any other comments that the public may have.

Steve stated that the goal of the Alternatives Meeting is to get the public's input on the best solution (alternative) within each of the four segments. After the meeting, Kimley-Horn will define the best solution for each segment, based on the individual segment analyses and public input from the meeting, and then put those together to define the best existing alignment alternative and the best realignment alternative.

Access Scenarios

Steve Godfrey briefly discussed with the CR members several access scenarios currently under consideration for the realignment alternatives. CR members discussed possible questions the public might ask.
